**Join us after the AGM for presentation by Michael Swinbourne:  
"Burrow occupancy and wombat behaviour at Moorunde"**

Mike Swinbourne is a PhD student at the University of Adelaide, where he is undertaking research to map the species-wide distribution of southern hairy-nosed wombats, and to work out how the population is changing over time in response to issues like land-use and climate change. He also recently conducted a project using Ground Penetrating Radar to map the underground extent of wombat warrens in different soil type. Mike came into wildlife research late in life, after a long career in the Royal Australian Air Force, where he served as a crew-member on P-3C Orion maritime patrol aircraft.

Mike is married to Alyce Swinbourne, who also undertakes research into wombats, and presented her research on the wombat oestrus cycle to the NHSSA at the AGM in 2017.
